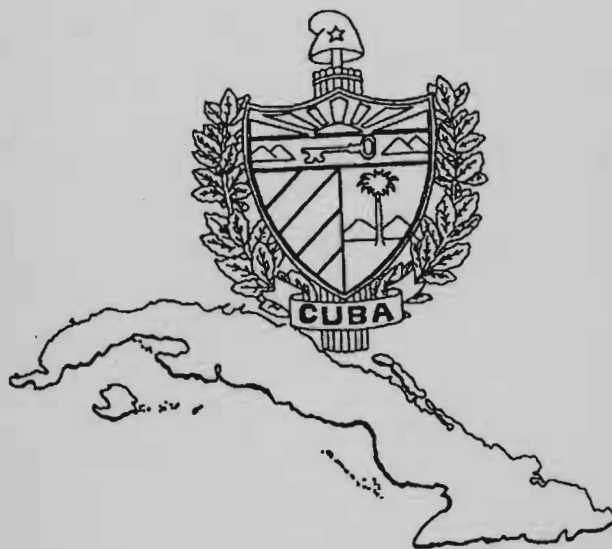


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EDITOR'S LETTER

HONORATO DEL CASTILLO

Honorato del Castillo

Honorato del Castillo was a young patriot that gave his life for Cuba's liberation effort.

Born in Sancti Spiritus on November 30th, 1838, he studied under the best teacher of the period, including José de la Luz y Caballero at the school *El Salvador*.

In 1866 he traveled to the United States, where he experienced the freedom that inspired him to fight for his countries' independence.

While attending the University of Habana he learned of the uprising in Yara and promptly traveled back to Sancti Spiritu to join the men that were at the front of the movement.

He died on an ambush by the Spaniard on July 22 1869, in the vicinity of Ciego de Avila.

He was involved in the fight for freedom for only 3 year, but his efforts were just as important as the effort of those that survived the war.

Discovery of a forgotten patriot

Without doubt, it is the discovery of interesting personalities that compels the researcher, in most cases, to continue searching through the complex history of his ancestors. In my case, discovering my great grandfather, José Guinot, was a surprise and source of pride.

José Guinot y Saavedra was born in Manzanillo, Oriente, in the year 1857. His father, José Guinot y Ponce de León, a military man originally from Sevilla, Spain and his mother, Saturnina Saavedra y Saavedra, originally from Holguín, Cuba, had married in Manzanillo on April 14, 1852.

Very few pieces of information have been found about the childhood and youth of José Guinot y Saavedra. He appears in a photo, at age 20, in which we can already see the resolution and energy of his character. He married young in Manzanillo with Blanca Fonseca y Heredia, originally of this same city. The offspring of that union were three daughters, named Blanca, Digna, and Zenaida. Years later, Zenaida married Pablo de Valencia, a Cuban doctor who performed the autopsy of José Martí. The vocation of Guinot was for literature and the arts, which materialized in sculptures and writing that were lost during the years of war, a misfortune for the national heritage and for that of his family.

According to Modesto Tirado, Guinot was "neat of dress, elegant in his manner, all wished to gain his friendship, always well groomed and with an intelligent look in his clear eyes". He, who had

been an unknown writer and teacher of Campechuela, who had just written a comedy about local customs, erupted suddenly into the political history of Cuba when the conspiracies and the work of organization that preceded the war organized by Martí from the United States began.

These were the days of the secret meetings with friends and later brothers in arms: Bartlomé Maño, Pedro Figueredo, *El Negro* Cerviño; when he personally directed the transportation and landing of arms and provisions coming from Jamaica, and, finally, a very heavy piece of equipment to a secret place in the ranch *Pablo Befuquero*: it was a printing press for the newspaper that they were planning to start to advance the cause of the war. Guinot was not a man of arms: the word and ideological activities were his tools of combat against the Spanish despotism. His war mission was to prepare his companions morally and patriotically.

The hard days of 1895 were upon them, Blanca Fonseca had found a note from her husband saying: "I leave for the forests, we will reunite soon." With him went Amador Guerra, Luis and Pedro Figueredo, Salvador and José González. It is said that when he arrived at the camp of the rebels, Guinot met with his old student *El Negro* Cerviño, who had risen to the post of Colonel. Guinot, who was a subordinate officer, exclaimed: "At your orders, my officer," to which Cerviño replied: "You are wrong, you are still my teacher."

With the support of General Maso, Guinot founded and directed, until 1898, the *Mambi* newspaper *La Independencia*, with the support of Federico Pérez Carbo, José Miro Argenter, Joaquín Castillo Duany, Rafael Portuondo, Fermín Valdés Domínguez, Modesto A. Tirado, Carlos Manuel de Céspedes y Quesada, and Enrique Collazo. They, and other distinguished patriots, would

send their contributions by mail for the newspaper, or personally visit the editor's office. *La Independencia* soon became one of the most important newspapers of the insurrection. From its pages Guinot and his writers uplifted the morale of the rebels and described with absolute truth the encounters between the Spaniards and the Cubans, giving the list of casualties of both sides. He was a trusted friend of Maso, who managed the finances of the revolution in the area of *Pablo Bejuquero*, and at the end of the war he gave Calixto García \$5000 that had been collected for some time.

Blanca Fonseca did not take long to depart with her three daughters to reunite with her husband in the forests. We can take a glance at the hard life in the war front by reading the letters that Guinot wrote to General Maso. In one of them, conserved in the National Archives he says: "My respected friend, I have arrived with fever after eleven days of painful marching. I am sick, and also my two daughter. My situation is very sad in terms of resources." And later on: "I would appreciate very much if you would take an interest in this matter, because we are suffering a very bad crisis." In 1897, for his many campaign merits, Guinot was promoted to the rank of major of the Liberation Army. Towards the end of the war this anecdote stayed in the mind of those who witnessed it: The US army was already involved in the conflict, and an American officer turned his back to Guinot, rudely, as Guinot was talking to him. The brave major, taking the man firmly by his shoulder, and turning him to face him, told him in perfect English: "You look at me in the eyes, you are talking to a man."

When the war was ended, Guinot, who had been named by Calixto García, commissioner of revenue in Manzanillo, returned with his family to his old house, and was not surprised to find it totally burned by the Spaniards. Filiberto Zayas Bazan, in a friendly gesture, gave him his house in Campechuela, where the teacher and

journalist planned to continue his creative activities and to start a full time political career. In a letter Guinot wrote to Maso, we can find discord in the ranks of the Army, when he says: "Here nothing is respected: because of the attitude that I took in the elections, not allowing an imposed military candidacy, nor allowing pressure to be put on the electorate, measures will be taken against me that I do not want to enumerate. Later on he says: "in all, we are persecuted and we are contradicted in everything, all of us that have showed a liking for you or demonstrated our gratefulness in any way."

As a politician, he may have had a brilliant future ahead of him if it had not been for his delicate health, mistreated by the rigors of the forests. He had already become a candidate for the post of mayor of Manzanillo when he suffered internal bleeding during a long trip on horseback, that caused his death on September 17, 1898. He was forty one years old.

Even though his portrait, and other personal objects are in the *Museum Bacardí de Santiago de Cuba*, and even though there are thirteen issues of *La Independencia*, at the National Library of La Habana, the danger of his being forgotten always exists. This writing is a small attempt at vindication. Because they are written in these times, I find it right to close with the words of Modesto Tirado, written in 1947: "Guinot, you will not be forgotten by this generation that cannot even understand itself and that has much to learn from you, who lived a life natural and simple."

Regidores, Alcaldes and other Government posts in Matanzas.

This list of government official was in the working papers of Francisco Xavier de Santa Cruz. The titles are listed as abbreviation, for reason of space. A list of the original name of the post and a translation is given at the end of the article.

There is a note at the beginning of the list that reads:

In 1815 the post of Alcalde Ordinario was eliminated, by virtue of the naming of the Frist Governor of Matanzas. However, it seems that it did not take effect right away, since from February 5, 1846, the Alcaldes Ordinarios were only relegated to the authority of Justice of the Piece, according to the act on La Habana, and their job was reduced according to the expressed act.

Until July 27, 1859 the Alcaldes Ordinarios, Pedro Hernández, Diego Antonio Puentes, were to continue in their post. On January 23 1860, Alcaldes and Regidores Municipales were named, according to the Royal Decree of July 27, 1859, with only one Municipal Mayor and two Lieutenant Mayors or Second Mayors.

The transcriptions from the Parish of La Asunción, Guanabacoa, Habana are of selected families that were being studied at the time by Francisco Xavier de Santa Cruz and his associates. The extractions cover the years 1700 to 1899.

The information contained in the following listing has the same format as previously used. To recap: The surname and given name are found first, followed by the sex of the individual, the date of the marriage, a letter indicting whether the individual listed is the one being married (M), or is associated genealogically (G), this G follows the names of parents or other spouses and witnesses, if any. In the death the letter (D) is used to indicate the person that is deceased. The numbers at the very end refer to the page and entry number of the original transcription. These are helpful in looking at the individuals identified in a given entry and may also be used for further reference in corresponding with CGS to get a printout of the entry as it appears in the original transcription.
